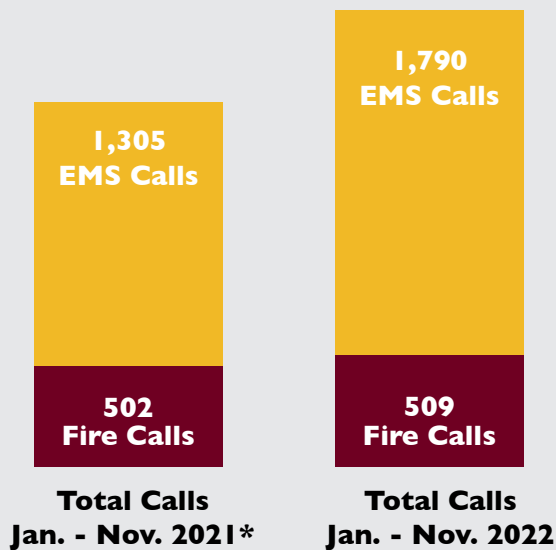
Why Donate?

Paoli Fire Company is on track to handle over 1,950 EMS responses in 2022, a nearly 35% increase in EMS responses from 2021.

Call Volumes are Increasing!



*PFC responded to 547 fire calls and 1,450 EMS calls in 2021, a total of 1,997 calls.

The costs to equip just one of Paoli’s 50 firefighters.

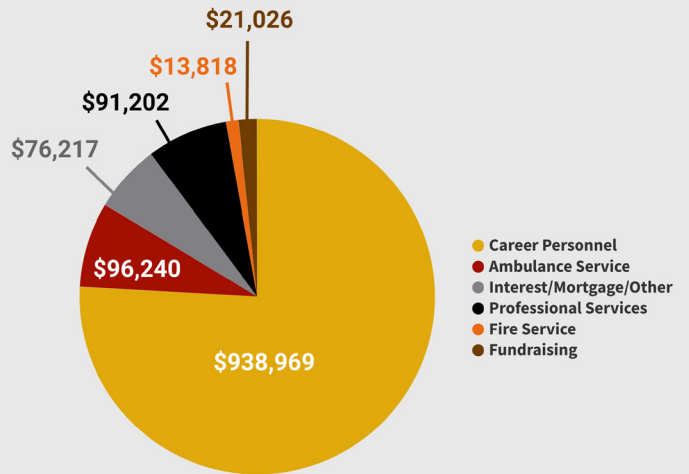


Our New Ambulance!

If You Need an Ambulance in 2023, Your Membership = Big Savings

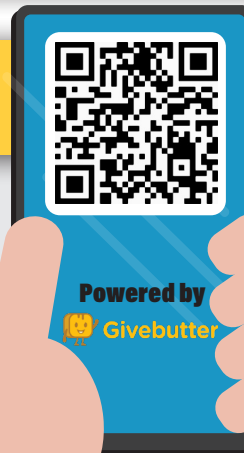
